## § 1

The Author warrants to the Publisher to have written the work titled
(hereinafter called the "Work") and undertakes to deliver it to the Publisher for publication.

## § 2

The Author warrants to the Publisher that the Work is original and does not contain fragments from previously published texts, which could cause the Publisher to infringe upon any previous copyright.

## § 3

The Author warrants to the Publisher that s/he is the sole Author of the Work; and that s/he is the owner of all the rights pertaining to the Work.

## § 4

The Author agrees for the Publisher to retain the customary right to make minor changes in style and language, and other accepted editorial changes to the Work without consultation as far as they do not alter the content of the Work.
§ 5
The Author agrees for the Publisher to make the Work available under the Creative Commons license CC BY-NC-ND 3.0, meaning that once it is made available by the Publisher, the Work may be distributed, copied and further shared (by other parties as well as the Author), albeit for non-commercial purposes only; it may not be altered (e.g. abbreviated) for any future use by a third party; it must always be attributed to the Author and a note of the licensing must be made.

## $\S 7$

The Author grants the Publisher the right to place the Work in electronic bases of academic publishers, electronic repositories, etc. selected by the Publisher.

The Publisher agrees to mail or otherwise deliver to the Author an electronic copy of the issue in which the published Work appears within 4 weeks of the date of publication.

Matters not covered by this agreement shall be governed by the Civil Code and relevant special provisions. § 10

The parties will endeavour to resolve amicably any disputes arising under the contract.
